Vacation is a welcome break!

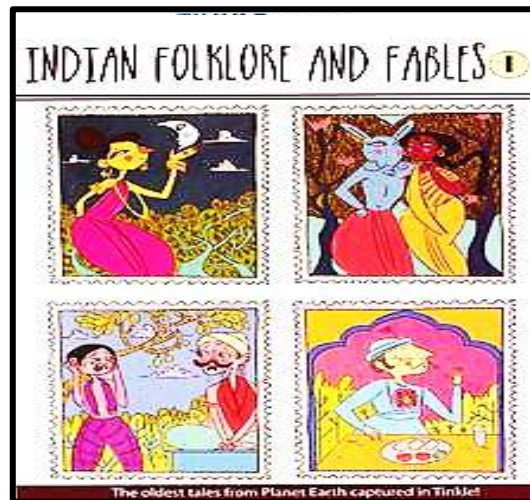

SUBJECT: MATHEMATICS

- Vedic Mathematics originated in ancient India during the Vedic period. It is a collection of Methods or Sutras to solve numerical computations quickly and faster. It consists of 16 Sutras called Formulae which can be applied to the solving of problems in arithmetic and geometry etc.
- Activity 1: Write any one Sutras of Vedic Maths and give its example.
- Activity -2 : Write the names of any 5 ancient cities of India and find their present population.(Take reference from your atlas)
- a) Arrange the cities in ascending order according to their population.

- b) Write their number names according to Indian and International Place Value system..
- c) Round off the population of the cities to the highest.
- d) Calculate the sum and difference of the greatest and the least population.
- 3. Warli art is a tribal art form that originated in the Western Ghats region of Maharashtra. Warli paintings are created by Warli tribe using simple geometric shapes like circles, triangles, squares, lines and dots.
