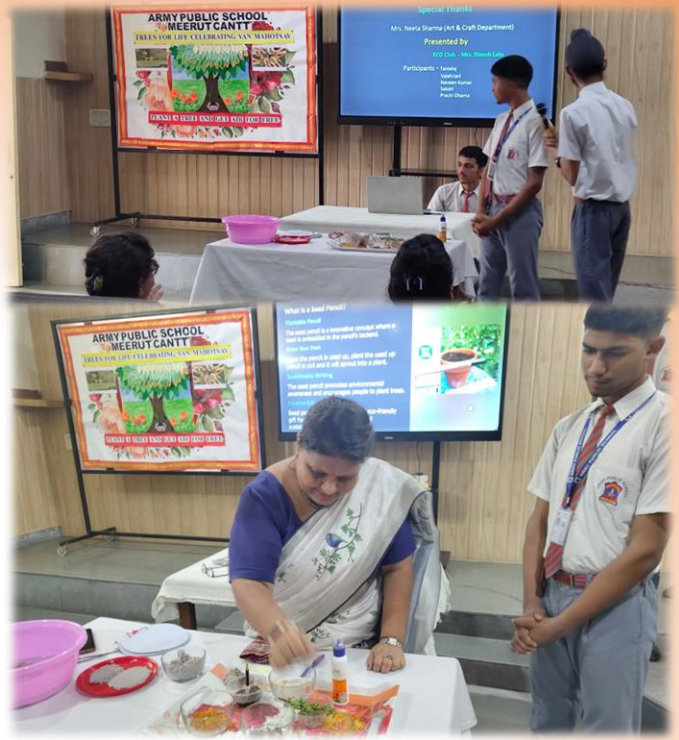
VAN MAHOTSAV CELEBRATION

MIND SPARK: IDEATHON 2024

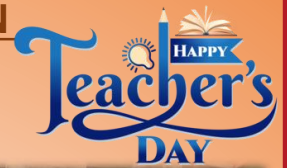
